2. Select School Fees
3. Select School Pay
4. Select Pay Fees
5. Enter Student Number
6. Enter amount to pay
7. Confirm transaction using your mobile money PIN

### GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

2. Immunization certification (photocopy)
