5. CO-CURRICULA ACTIVITIES.

- In sports we hosted the annual zonal COPA COCA COLA football championships, and finished in 5th position out of 12 schools.
- The school Basketball team participated in the "All Stars" National basketball school championships at Seeta High School and the boy's team emerged 2nd runners up. While the girls were eliminated at quarter finals stage.
- The Basketball team also participated In the National qualifiers at St Mary's College and qualified for the district regional qualifiers (4th position). We pray that they also qualify for the National Championships that are scheduled for the holiday.
- Our volleyball school team participated in the Entebbe zonal District qualifiers and managed to qualify for the Wakiso district championships.
- The Inter-house sports competitions were held between 18th and 23rd April and they will be concluded in second term with the school sports day.
- The School Debating Club also qualified to participate in the Grand National Debate Tournament to be held at Nyakasura School, Fort Portal from 13th - 17th May 2019.

6. DISCIPLINE.

I wish to appreciate those parents that have partnered with us in fighting indiscipline in the school. Some students have been suspended indefinitely, because they have fallen short of our discipline standards.
